What to Bring To Pre-Easter 2019

Clothes:

- Camp Clothes - jeans, shorts & shirts (all attire should be modest)
- Underwear and socks
- Modest pajamas
- Swimsuit, cover-up and shoes for swimming
Girls will need to wear a dark t-shirt if wearing a two-piece
- Jacket and/or Raincoat
- Comfortable shoes - tennis shoes for rec and walking

Personal Items:

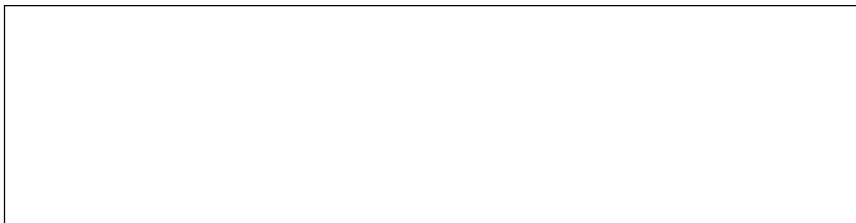
- Pillow, sleeping bag or twin sheets & blanket
- Soap , shampoo & hair care items
- Deodorant
- Towels & washcloths
- Toothbrush and toothpaste

Miscellaneous:

- Bible & pen/pencil
- Flashlight
- Watch
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Money for Thursday Night Food Trucks, concessions & gift shop

Medication:

Prescription or over-the-counter drugs will be collected by the camp nurse for dispensing. ***Instructions for dispensing should be noted on the Camper Registration/Medical Release form.*



Basic Pre-Easter Retreat Rules

1. **Personal Responsibility** — Respect others and the camp property. Any actions that may cause injury, damage, or harm to you or any other person or property should be avoided.
2. **Safety** — Camp Sponsors are given guidelines and emergency procedures. Follow all facility and safety instructions given by Sponsors for your own personal wellbeing.
3. **Medical Protocol** - Each camper must provide a completed and signed Medical Release Form and all personal medical prescriptions must be given to the Alto Frio Nurse upon arrival. The AF Nurse has oversight of all first-aid and medical situations.
4. **Property** — Each retreat is assigned specific buildings and areas. Please go into those areas only. The River is not part of Alto Frio Camp property. Campers should not go into the river unless part of a scheduled event.
5. **Curfew** — Curfew for camp activities is 12:00 midnight unless otherwise noted. All campers should be in their assigned dorms by that time.
6. **Vehicle Usage** - Vehicles must be parked in designated areas during the retreat. Campers are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle, including golf carts.
7. **Dress Code** - For personal safety, shoes will be worn outdoors at all times. All clothing worn at camp should meet the highest Christian standards. Campers wearing clothing that is too revealing (short, tight or low-cut), displays inappropriate messages, or draws unnecessary attention will be asked to change into appropriate clothing. Swimsuits are allowed to be worn only when the pool & river are open for swimming & two-piece swimsuits must be covered by a dark-colored t-shirt.
8. **Restrictions** —The following items/activities are prohibited: Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, weapons of any kind (including pocket knives), fireworks, pets, ATVs, skateboards, rollerblades, skates, public displays of affection & multiple students sharing a bed.

Alto Frio operates under an annual permit issued by the Texas Department of Health and is required to operate according to the Texas Youth Camp Safety and Health Act. Camp policies, rules and procedures reflect those requirements.
